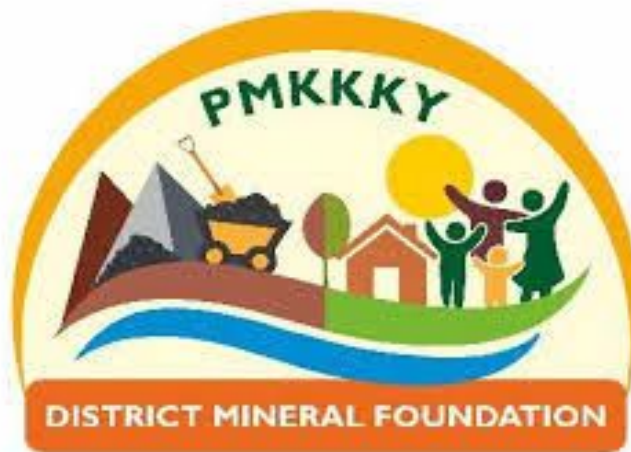

Aligning with the goals of DMF as per the PMKKKY guidelines, various schemes are being implemented in the district of Ramgarh to develop mining affected areas in the sectors of health, education, livelihoods and to improve the standards of living

Under the DMF in the blocks Mandu, Patratu and Chitarpur 46,675 individual toilets have been constructed. In addition to it, with the aim of providing safe drinking water to each and every one the district has deployed 291 Solar Water schemes in Schools, tolas and Rural areas. Renovation and beautification of ponds and Bandh have been carried out to preserve the Environment. To improve connectivity 47 schemes have been carried out for the construction and renovation of bridges.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the people of Ramgarh, the board of trustees, the various line departments and other stakeholders without whose cooperation and unwavering commitment many of the initiatives would have never seen the light of day. I assure you that we have taken utmost care to ensure that the funds accrued under DMF are managed and utilised as per Jharkhand DMF Rules, notified by the state government.

1. Executive Summary

This report discusses the objectives, planning, schemes undertaken and the achievements by the implementation of District Mineral Foundation Trust Fund utilised in Dhanbad district. The District Mineral Foundation (DMF) is a trust set up as a non-profit body established in those districts affected by mining works with an objective to work for the development of the people directly or indirectly affected by mining in the region. The trust is funded through the royalty fund collected by all the mining companies in the area. DMF funds are treated as extra-budgetary resources for the State Plan. Efforts are made to achieve convergence with the State and the District Plans so that the activities taken up by the DMF can supplement the development and welfare activities already being carried out.

In the year 2016-17, more than 561 projects were carried out under different sectors such as drinking water, health, education, etc. with the aim of transforming the district. Total funds received by the district was approx 206 Cr with opening balance for the financial year starting in 2018 at approx 0 Cr. Approximately 52 cr was spent on the various development activities in the district. At the end of the financial year 2017 the account balance was approx 155 Cr. 48% of the total sanctioned amount was for construction of toilets, 22% is for the drinking water sector, 16% for the upgradation of infrastructure and the remaining for other sectors.

DMF is focussing on the various facets of human developments and has focussed on the basic infrastructure. In the context of education, various activities were carried out to improve the educational infrastructure. To improve healthcare facilities in the district, recruitment of specialist doctors, renovation of district hospital and setting up of blood bank was done. To develop the infrastructural capacity of the district various bridges, market complex, crematorium and panchayat growth centre were constructed.

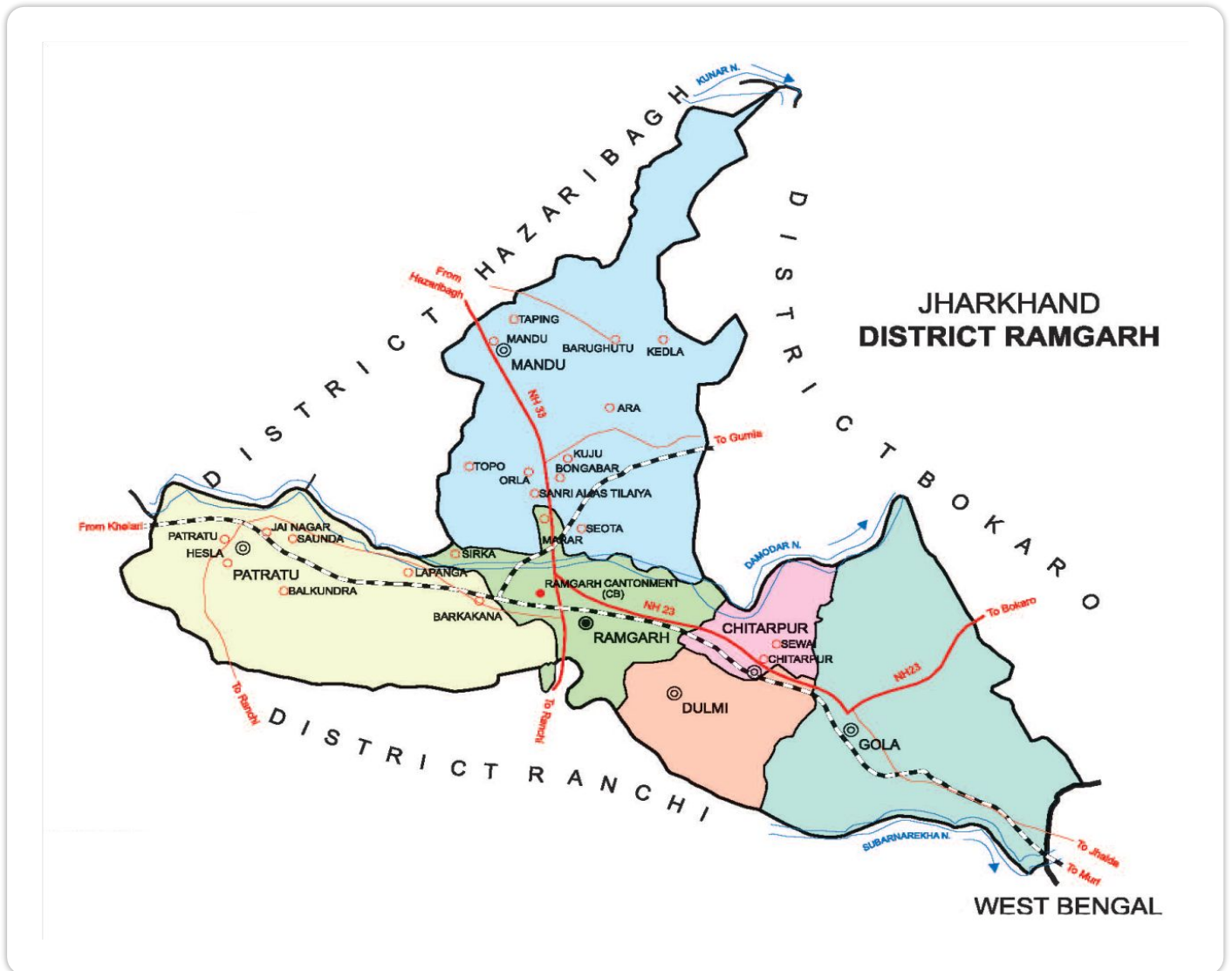
Following are the list of successful projects in the districts:

1. Construction of toilets to make Ramgarh Open Defecation Free
2. Construction of Bridges to improve the connectivity to each and every part of the district.
3. Various solar water projects were carried out in the district.

Going forward various activities are planned, in the Drinking Sector, 14 projects have been planned to provide drinking water supply to rural household. In Education, Construction of State Scheduled Tribe Residential School Building in Mandu Block under Ramgarh District. To improve the infrastructure facilities 35 projects have been planned for the Construction of bridges. To improve the sanitation facilities 3051 projects have been planned.

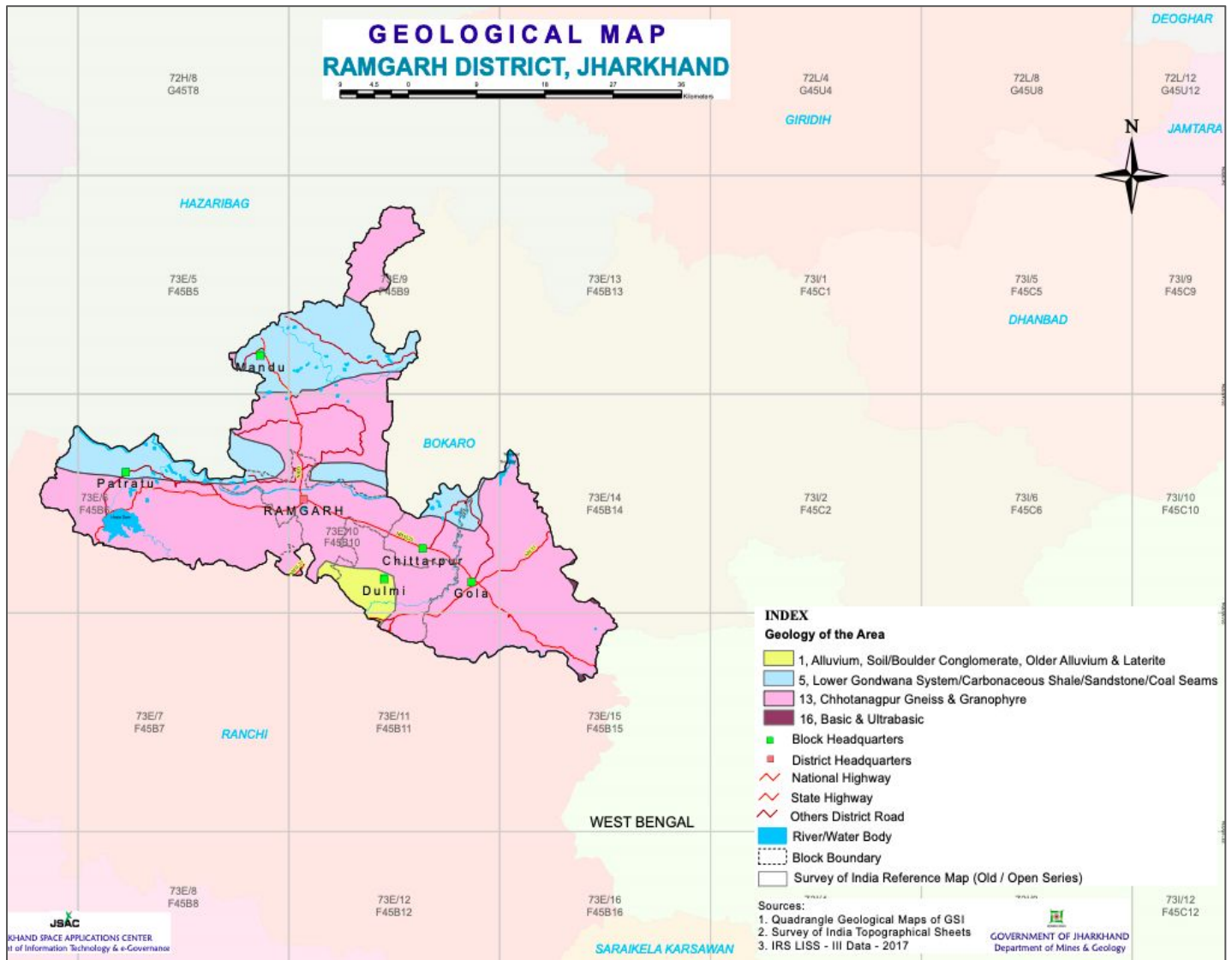
Mineral Overview of Ramgarh

District Mineral Foundation Trust

What is DMFT

District Mineral Foundations (DMF) are statutory bodies established by the State Governments by notification. They derive their legal status from section 9B of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 as amended on 26th March, 2015 as Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2015. This amendment came into force from 12th January, 2015. Each DMF is a trust established in the mining affected districts across the country.

The objective of DMF is to work for the interest of the persons and areas affected by mining related operations in such manner as may be prescribed by the State Government, from time to time.

Mission

The mission of the District Mineral Foundation (DMF) Trust is to “work for the welfare and development of mining affected communities”.

Vision

The vision of the District Mineral Foundation (DMF) Trust is to “alleviate the adverse impacts of mining on communities and environment, and create sustainable development opportunities for current and future generations”.

Functions of the TRUST

The DMF Trust is responsible for:

- a) The implementation of various welfare and developmental projects in mining affected areas
- b) Minimizing/mitigating the adverse impacts, during and after mining, on the environment, health and socio-economic status of the people in mining areas
- c) Ensuring long term sustainable livelihoods for the affected people in mining areas

It undertakes the following activities for this purpose:

- a) Receive, maintain, manage, release and utilize the funds accrued
- b) Plan, identify, design and undertake suitable welfare and developmental projects, following due procedure
- c) Monitor and coordinate with various executing agencies at field level for successful implementation of projects taken up
- d) Ensure convergence with ongoing/existing schemes/projects of State and Central Government
- e) Identify and promote innovative solutions
- f) Ensure regular and swift redressal of grievances
- g) Coordinate with Planning and Convergence Department (GoO) and Steel and Mines Department (GoO)
- h) Any other work entrusted

About Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojna (PMKKKY)

Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojana (PMKKKY) is a programme launched on 17 September 2015 to provide for the welfare of areas and people affected by mining related operations. PMKKKY is implemented by the District Mineral Foundations (DMFs) of the respective districts using the funds accruing to the DMF from miners. (Khanij means Mineral and Kshetra means area or field in Hindi. Kalyan stands for welfare and Yojana stands for a Plan or project). The Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojana (PMKKKY) will be implemented by the District Mineral Foundations (DMFs) of the respective districts using the funds accruing to the DMF.

Objectives of PMKKKY

The overall objective of PMKKKY scheme will be

- (a) to implement various developmental and welfare projects/programs in mining affected areas, and these projects/programs will be complementing the existing ongoing schemes/projects of State and Central Government
- (b) to minimize/mitigate the adverse impacts, during and after mining, on the environment, health and socio-economics of people in mining districts
- (c) to ensure long-term sustainable livelihoods for the affected people in mining areas.

Governance & Management of DMFT

MMDR Amendment 2015 requires State Governments to establish District Mineral Foundation (DMF) as per section 9B, that will be used for development of mining affected people and the areas. All DMFs shall also implement Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojana (PMKKKY) notified on 16 September 2015. Accordingly, Government of Jharkhand issued a notification for constitution of DMF Trust in each district of Jharkhand on 24 November 2015 along with the details of the Governing Council and Managing Committees (Gazette No. 854 dated 07 December 2015). Further, Jharkhand District Mineral Foundation (Trust) Rules, 2016 was notified on 22 March 2016 (Gazette No. 218 dated 23 Mar 2016) and they were extended for minor minerals, too, on 13 January 2017. (Gazette No 109 dated 27 Jan 2017).

Date of Formation: 15th March 2016

Managing Committee

The Management of the Trust vests in a Governing Council, which consists of all the members of the Trust. However, the day to day management of the Trust is be managed by a Managing Committee.

The Managing Committee is responsible for –

- Coordinating, consolidating and developing the annual plan of the Trust as per the provisions laid in the guidelines of Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojna (PMKKKY).
- Approving the lists of work under Priority and other priority areas beneficiaries as identified by the committee;
- Distributing monetary benefits through bank transfer to the beneficiaries under extreme cases on approval of the Governing Council. Explanation: Families displaced by very old mines and resettled in a different village, as identified under Rule 12(3)(c)(ii), is not to be considered as beneficiary. For the purpose of this sub-rule, for distributing monetary benefits priorities is given to those living below poverty line, orphans, widows, single mothers, physically challenged persons, senior citizens, etc.
- Undertaking such other activities as are in furtherance of the objective of the Trust, and as per the provisions laid in the guidelines of PMKKKY.
- Appointing officers to run the Trust and auditors; however, these appointments requires ratification by the Governing Council;
- Organising meetings of the Trust;
- Presenting audit reports for ratification to the Governing Council.

Governing Council

The functions of the Governing Council are as follows:

- Laying down the broad policy framework for the functioning of Trust and reviewing its working from time to time.
- Drawing up and approving of Annual Action Plan and the Annual Budget for Trust. The Annual Action plan is prepared and approved by the Governing Council at least one month before commencement of the year. The Annual Action Plan contains the list of schemes and projects with the tentative provisions thereof. Provided that if for any reason whatsoever, the Governing Council does not prepare and accord approval to the Annual Plan and the Budget within the specified time, the Chairman shall have Annual Action Plan and the Budget of the Trust prepared to approve the same. The Budget so prepared shall be deemed to have been duly prepared and approved by the Governing Council. Provided also that while preparing the annual plan for the next financial year, the sum total of the past commitment and liabilities spilling over shall be assessed. To maintain financial discipline and timely completion of project, the sum total of the past liabilities and commitments and the new schemes being proposed should not in any case exceed three times the expected inflows for the next financial year.
- Approving such other expenditure, in furtherance of the objects of the Trust from the available Trust Fund in such manner as may be prescribed by the settlor.
- Approving the recommendations of the Managing Committee;
- Approving the annual reports and audited accounts of the Trust within 60 days of the close of the previous year;

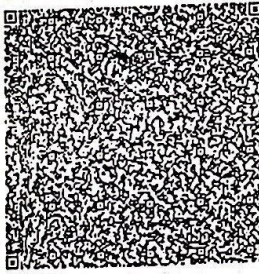

Contribution to DMF Fund

Rate of Contributions to the DMFT is as follows:

- 30% of the royalty amount payable for major mineral mines allocated before 12.01.2015 and for the existing minor mineral leases which are not granted through auction.
- 10% of the royalty amount payable from leaseholder for major mineral mines allocated after 12.01.2015 and for minor mineral leases which are granted through auction.

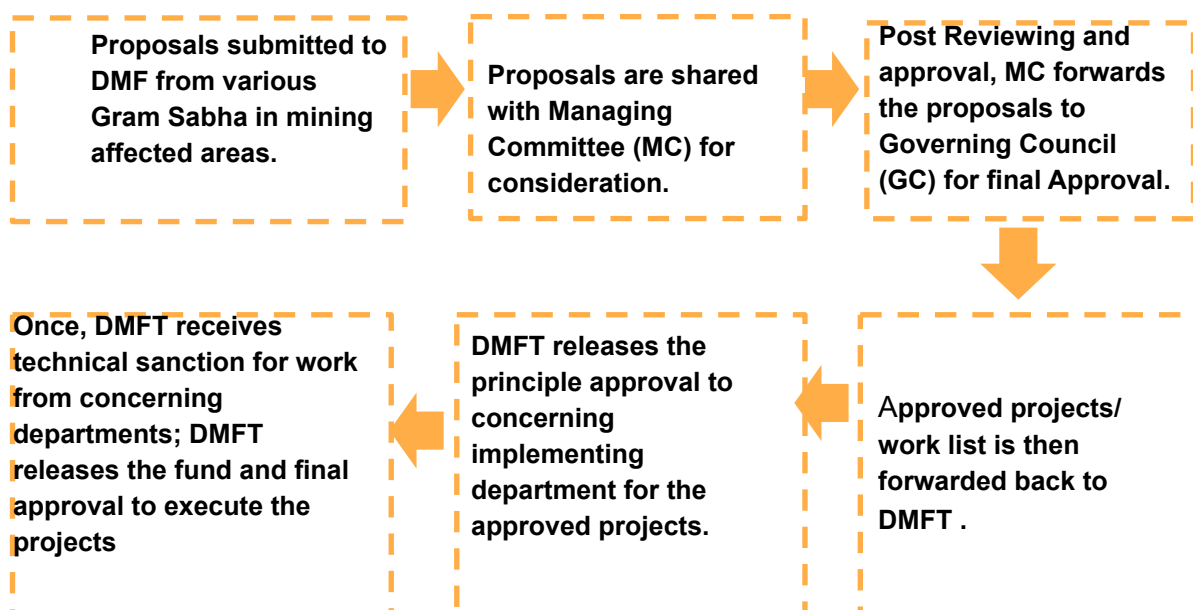

Annual Planning Process

DMFT practice a bottom-up planning approach to understand people's needs and include such considerations in the DMF plan. As per provisions of Jharkhand DMFT Rules 2016, selection of schemes is to be done entirely by the Gram Sabha and as per provisions of PMKKKY guidelines. The Gram Sabha in consultation with the Mukhiya / Up-mukhiya has to identify works to be carried out under priority and other priority areas. The Managing Committee does not have any overriding power on selection or approval of the schemes.

Administrative Process of Approving Projects



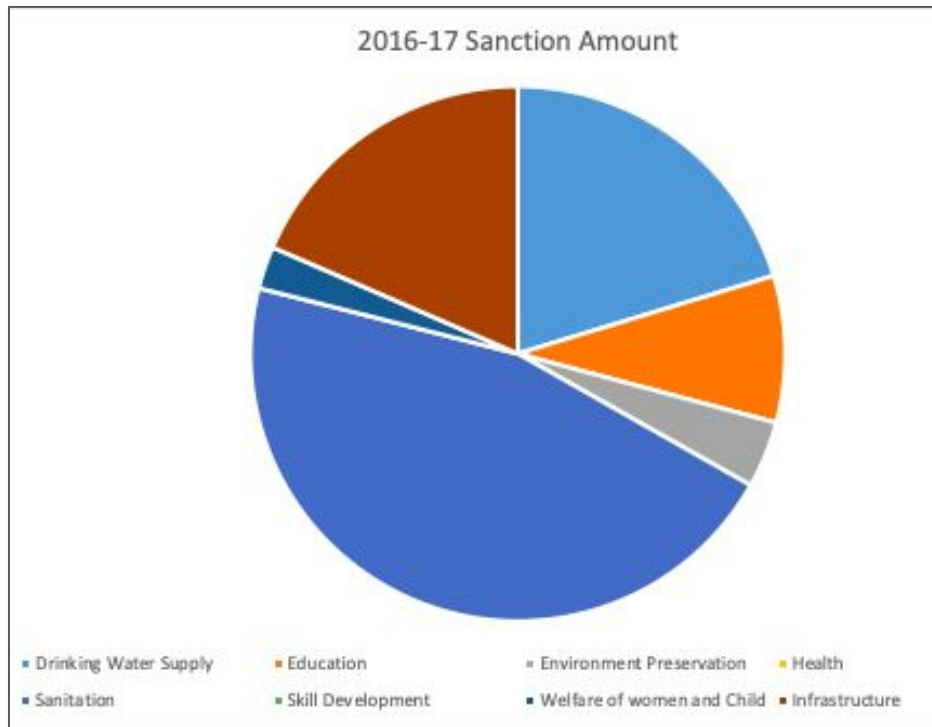


6 Projects under PMKKKY Scheme



Sector-wise Fund Allocation

The Ramgarh District Administration as per the PMKKKY guidelines, allocated an amount of **1,22,39,91,156.00** from the DMFT to uplift the mining affected populace for the year 2016-17. Out of the total funds, 46% is allocated towards improving sanitation facility in Ramgarh, 20% towards drinking water, 18% towards infrastructure, 9% in Education, 4% towards Environmental Protection, 3% towards Welfare of Women & Children and the remaining in other Sectors.



2018-19 Fund Analysis

The table on the right shows the sanctioned amount by DMFT for the various sectors

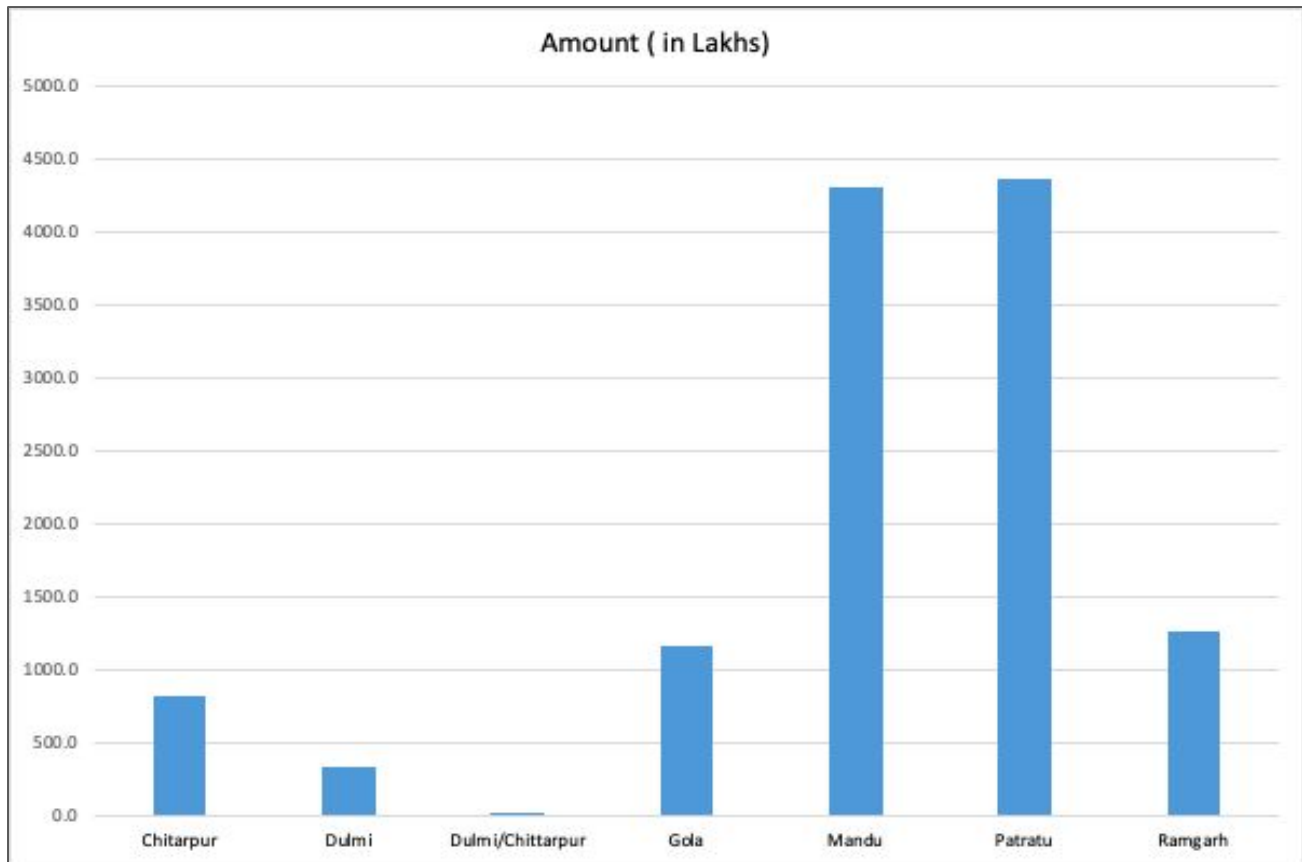
Out of the total sanctioned amount 81.5% was allocated towards the high priority sectors such as those of drinking water supply, education, health, skill development and welfare of women and children. Further, 18.4 % was allocated towards other priority areas such as that of infrastructure.

514 schemes were sanctioned in the high priority areas while 47 were those in the other priority areas.

The total sanctioned amount in all the sectors was **1,22,39,91,156.00** with approximately 46% being allocated towards the improvement of sanitation facilities in Ramgarh.

Improving Access to Safe Drinking Water through Solar Drinking Water

Summary:

Ramgarh being a mining area, availability of clean drinking water is a major challenge in the district. Given the high levels of pollution, only treated tap water/treated piped can be assumed to be relatively safe. The project aims at providing safe drinking water to each and every household.

Earlier people used to mainly depend either on the water from hand pumps or unsafe water from river or ponds which they had to carry from distant places. Due to the initiatives that are being taken now, people are able to get water at their doorsteps which helps them save time and reduces the excessive labor that was done to carry the water from far off places. Filtration plants have been installed so as to get rid of any harmful impurities and to make water safe for consumption.

Problem:

Due to the unavailability of clean drinking water and poor sanitation, incidences of water and vector-borne diseases such as diarrhea and malaria are high, particularly amongst children. Data from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (2017), indicates that children below the age of five years are particularly vulnerable to these. The problem is pervasive across urban and rural areas.

Anganwadis: Categorically 30 to 40 percent of AWCs (except for in Ramgarh) do not have drinking water facilities within premises. Out of the overall 1037 anganwadis in the district, 37.3 % of the overall anganwadis lack drinking water facilities as per the studies conducted by CSE.

Schools: In Schools access to tap water is very limited. As per the report by the DISE 2015-16, only 6.7 % of the schools have access to tap water facilities with Gola and Dulmi being the most affected having merely 1.4 and 1.3 % of the schools with tap water facilities respectively.

Rural Areas: The proportion of tap water facilities is barely above one percent in rural areas, which is a key concern for children's health. Categorically more than 90 percent of schools in the district do not have tap water facilities.

Most of the households rely heavily on untreated groundwater sourced through hand pumps or uncovered wells. In Patrattu and Chitarpur, the proportion of households using treated tap water is only slightly better, about 38 percent and 26 percent respectively. The proportion is alarmingly low in the rural mining-affected block Gola where the access is a mere two percent. While Patrattu being a predominantly urban area is slightly better off but even there about 62 percent of households do not have access to treated tap water. Scientific studies on water pollution in Ramgarh district (including sampling areas around the coal mines) have shown the presence of heavy metals such as iron and lead exceed the prescribed limits. Apart from the presence of these two metals, the Rajrappa area has also recorded the presence of cobalt beyond permissible limits.

Work done under the Initiative

Taking into account the situation on the ground, the following initiatives were taken up by the District Administration:

Solar Powered water pumps -This particular project aimed at providing access to water in places where laying of piped water wasn't feasible due to electricity and other issues. Mostly the project is in areas where handpumps were earlier installed, power from the solar panels is used to extract water from the ground and store in tankers with a capacity of 4000 liters. On an average each project is able to serve almost 25-30 households. All in all the project was able to impact almost 74.2 thousand people.

Outcome

Listed below are the details of the initiatives and the impact created:

1. Total Number of 483 Solar Water plants are established benefitting 74,204 people.
2. Self-sustenance of the project by involving Mukhiyas and getting a committee within the village for maintenance and monitoring.
3. The improved reach of clean and safe water to AWC, Schools and Rural Population.
4. Reducing the efforts and time required to fetch safe drinking water. Earlier people used to collect water from the river which required massive efforts and a lot of time was also invested in fetching it.
5. Initiatives were made keeping in mind the reducing water table, the project keeps in mind this fact and tries to address the reducing water issues too through soak pits that were constructed to address the issue.

Making Ramgarh Open Defecation Free



Problem:

According to the census of 2011, 53.1% (63.6% in 2001) of the households in India do not have a toilet, with the percentage being as high as 69.3% (78.1% in 2001) in rural areas and 18.6% (26.3% in 2001) in urban areas.

Open defecation is a major cause of fatal diarrhea. Everyday about 2000 children aged less than five succumb to diarrhea and every 40 seconds a life is lost. In rural settings where open defecation is prevalent, large amounts of fecal pathogens via human and animal feces, are ingested by children. This creates a massive reservoir of bacteria, parasites and viruses that keep spreading gastrointestinal infection. An eventual result is growth stunting and malnutrition.

Solution:

Ramgarh Swachhta Sangram was the ODF drive which was carried out in the district. During this drive, convergence with DMF (T) was done to ensure regular fund flow and to improve the quality of toilets. A total of 56.01 crores of DMF (T) funds was utilised for toilet construction.

Ramgarh was the first district in Jharkhand to be declared Open Defecation Free. The district is now working towards ODF plus, wherein hand wash units have been installed in all schools and anganwadi centres in the district. Soak pits have been constructed wherever required. A campaign on menstrual hygiene is currently underway.

Outcome/ Impact:

With this project 46675 households have been impacted by providing them with toilets in their homes.





Way Forward

The Ramgarh District Administration as per the PMKKKY guidelines, allocated an amount of **1,22,39,91,156.00** from the DMFT to uplift the mining affected populace for the year 2016-17. Out of the total funds, 90 % is allocated towards drinking water supply in Ramgarh, 45.7 % is allocated towards improving sanitation and the remaining in other sectors.

Various activities and projects have been planned to improve the living conditions of people in the mining areas. The various panchayats through Gram Sabhas have also decided a number of schemes to be taken up in different sectors of health, education, sanitation, environment conservation and beautification etc. in the areas impacted by mining operations.

In the drinking water supply sector, 14 projects have been planned to provide drinking water supply to rural households. In the education sector, construction of a Scheduled Tribe residential school building in Mandu block is to be taken up. To improve the infrastructure facilities, 35 bridge construction projects have been planned. To improve the sanitation facilities in the district, 3051 projects have been planned.

In the coming years, DMFT will make the planning process more participative and bottom-up through usage of Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) tools and need analysis. This will help in attainment of the objectives of DMFT and PMKKKY in letter as well as spirit in these mining affected regions.

2. सर्वप्रथम उपायुक्त महोदया द्वारा DMFT के न्यास परिषद की प्रथम बैठक में उपस्थित न्यास परिषद के सभी सदस्यों का अभिवादन करते हुए उपस्थित माननीय सांसद/विधायक के प्रतिनिधि, मुखिया, उपमुखिया/प्रमुख एवं उपप्रमुख तथा पदाधिकारियों को रामगढ़ जिला खनिज फाउण्डेशन ट्रस्ट(DMFT) एवं इसके तहत कार्यान्वित की जाने वाली योजनाओं की प्रकृति, उद्देश्य, लक्ष्य एवं इसके परिणाम स्वरूप जिला में अत्यावधि एवं दीर्घावधि की योजनाओं के कार्यान्वयन से होने वाली गुणात्मक एवं संरचनात्मक विकास के संबंध में विस्तार पूर्वक बताया गया। साथ ही, DMFT के नियमों, प्रावधानों आदि से पूर्णतः अवगत होने के उद्देश्य से सभी सदस्यों को मार्ग-दर्शिका भी उपलब्ध कराया गया। इसके उपरान्त जिला योजना पदाधिकारी-सह-प्रभारी पदाधिकारी, विकास शाखा, रामगढ़ को Power Point Presentation के माध्यम से सभी सदस्यों को वर्ष 2016-17 के तहत कार्यान्वित की जाने वाली योजनाओं के अनुमोदन हेतु प्रस्तुतीकरण करने का निदेश दिया गया।



सर्वप्रथम बैठक में उपस्थित सदस्यों का अभिवादन करते हुए उपायुक्त महोदया द्वारा बताया गया कि आज की प्रबंधकीय समिति की बैठक का मुख्य उद्देश्य DMFT के अन्तर्गत स्वीकृत योजनाओं के त्वरित कार्यान्वयन, नयी योजनाओं के अनुमोदन, Innovative एवं रोजगार परक योजनाओं के चयन तथा Project Management Unit के गठन एवं अन्य महत्वपूर्ण विषयों पर विचार-विमर्श के लिए आयोजित किया गया है। तदोपरान्त जिला योजना पदाधिकारी, रामगढ़ को एजेन्डावार विषय वस्तु प्रस्तुत करने का निदेश दिया।

निदेशानुसार जिला योजना पदाधिकारी, रामगढ़ द्वारा समिति के विचारार्थ एजेन्डावार विषय वस्तु को प्रस्तुत किया गया :-

i. District Project Management Unit का गठन

जिला योजना पदाधिकारी, रामगढ़ द्वारा बताया गया कि DMFT की मार्ग-दर्शिका में DPMU के गठन का प्रावधान है तथा राज्य स्तरीय समीक्षात्मक बैठक में सचिव महोदया द्वारा भी इसके लिए निदेशित किया गया है। विचारोपरान्त DMFT के तहत सभी कार्यों के त्वरित गति से संचालन तथा नियमित अनुश्रवण के लिए सरकार से प्राप्त मार्ग-निदेश के आलोक में District Project Management Unit का गठन करने का निर्णय लिया गया। इसके अन्तर्गत Project Officer, Programmer, Accountant तथा Computer Operator के पद पर क्रमशः एक-एक कर्मी को नियुक्त करने का निर्णय लिया गया। सभी पदों के लिए योग्यता तथा मानदेय राशि का निर्धारण (परिशिष्ट "क") करते हुए अविलम्ब विज्ञापन प्रकाशित करने का निर्णय लिया गया। साथ ही, समय-सीमा के अन्दर प्राप्त आवेदक की सम्यक जाँच करके आवश्यकतानुसार लिखित परीक्षा/साक्षात्कार के आधार पर योग्य अभ्यर्थियों का चयन करते हुए निम्नवत् गठन किया गया :-

ii. Discussion on Central team Suggestion

रामगढ़ जिले के अन्तर्गत DMFT के तहत प्रथम वर्ष 2016-17 के लिए तैयार किये गये Annual Action Plan के अवलोकन तथा उस पर विचार-विमर्श के पश्चात् दिल्ली से आयी टीम द्वारा दिये गये Feedback के आधार पर Centre for Science and Environment के Deputy Director General श्री चन्द्र भूषण से प्राप्त लिखित सुझाव पर चर्चा की गयी। इसके अन्तर्गत शिक्षा, स्वास्थ्य, स्वच्छता, रोजगार, स्वरोजगार, प्रशिक्षण आदि विषयों में प्राप्त सुझाव के आलोक में वर्णित प्रत्येक बिन्दु पर सुझाव से विचार करते हुए तत्काल DMF के तहत रामगढ़ जिला के

लिए वृहत पंच वर्षीय तथा वार्षिक कार्य योजना तैयार करते हुए Expression of Interest निकाल कर एक Expert Team का Selection करने का निर्णय लिया गया। साथ ही, यह भी निर्णय लिया गया कि उक्त Expert Team सम्पूर्ण रामगढ़ जिला विशेषकर खनन से प्रभावित क्षेत्रों का House to House Survey करके आवश्यकता आधारित Plan तैयारी करेगी।

iii. नयी पद्धति से विद्यालयों में चाहारदिवारी निर्माण

जिला योजना पदाधिकारी, रामगढ़ द्वारा बताया गया कि DMFT के तहत कुल 88 विद्यालयों में चाहारदिवारी निर्माण की योजना को अनुमोदित किया गया है। इसके लिए कार्यपालक अभियंता, एन0आर0ई0पी0, रामगढ़ एवं जिला अभियंता, जिला परिषद्, रामगढ़ से प्राक्कलन की मांग की गयी थी। दोनों अभियंताओं से तकनीकी स्वीकृति प्रदत्त प्राक्कलन प्राप्त हुआ है लेकिन दोनों प्राक्कलनों की दर में भिन्नता है। इससे संबंधित B.K. Technology, Gujrat से एक प्रस्ताव प्राप्त हुआ है, जिसमें परम्परागत ईंट की जगह Concrete Plank and Post के द्वारा चाहारदिवारी निर्माण का प्रस्ताव दिया गया है। प्रस्ताव में Concrete Plank से निर्मित दीवार को ईंट से निर्मित दीवार की अपेक्षा मजबूत और सस्ता होने का भी उल्लेख है।

बैठक में उपस्थित सभी कार्यपालक अभियंता द्वारा Concrete Plank से निर्मित दीवार को ईंट की दीवार से अधिक मजबूत होने की बात की पुष्टि की गयी। चर्चा के क्रम में कार्यपालक अभियंताओं द्वारा Concrete Plank का Scheduled दर नहीं होने का उल्लेख किया गया। दीवार की मजबूती, Innovative तकनीक तथा गुणवत्ता में एकरूपता पर विचार करते हुए निविदा के माध्यम से दर निर्धारण तथा आपूर्तिकर्ता के चयन हेतु निविदा के प्रकाशन का निर्णय लिया गया। निविदा के लिए निम्नवत् त्रि-सदस्यीय समिति का गठन किया गया :-

- 1) कार्यपालक अभियंता, ग्रामीण विकास विशेष प्रमण्डल, हजारीबाग-सह-रामगढ़।
- 2) कार्यपालक अभियंता, पेयजल एवं स्वच्छता प्रमण्डल, रामगढ़।
- 3) कार्यपालक अभियंता, भवन प्रमण्डल, रामगढ़।

उक्त कार्यपालक अभियंताओं को तीन दिनों के अन्दर NIA तैयार कर प्रस्तुत करने का निदेश दिया गया, ताकि तदनुसार निविदा का प्रकाशन किया जा सके।

iv. योजना का चयन

बैठक में उपस्थित सभी कार्यपालक अभियंता तथा सभी प्रखण्ड विकास पदाधिकारी को वैसी महत्वपूर्ण जनोपयोगी योजनाओं को चिन्हित कर सूचीबद्ध कर ग्राम सभा से पारित कराकर समर्पित करने का निदेश दिया गया, जिनका कार्यान्वयन किसी अन्य विभाग से कराने के लिए सरकार से आवंटन प्राप्त होने की संभावना नहीं है।

A. पंचायत भवन की चाहारदिवारी :-

प्रखण्ड विकास पदाधिकारियों द्वारा प्रस्तावित रामगढ़ जिलान्तर्गत सभी पंचायत भवनों की सुरक्षा हेतु जिन पंचायतों के पंचायत भवनों में चाहारदिवारी उपलब्ध नहीं है, वहाँ चाहारदिवारी निर्माण करने का निर्णय लिया गया। तदनुसार सभी प्रखण्ड विकास पदाधिकारियों को विधिवत् पूर्ण विवरणी के साथ प्रस्ताव समर्पित करने का निदेश दिया गया।

B. SHG प्रशिक्षण भवन :-

रामगढ़ जिला में SHG को सुदृढ़, संगठित एवं सशक्त करने के लिए प्रखण्ड स्तर पर प्रशिक्षण भवन के निर्माण पर विचार किया गया। प्रखण्ड विकास पदाधिकारियों द्वारा बताया गया कि पूर्व में कुछ प्रखण्डों में प्रशिक्षण भवन बना है। सभी प्रखण्ड विकास पदाधिकारियों को इसकी वर्तमान स्थिति एवं उपयोग से अवगत कराने का निदेश दिया गया।

C. आदिवासी आवासीय उच्च विद्यालय, माण्डू का जीर्णोद्धार :-

आदिवासी आवासीय उच्च विद्यालय, माण्डू का भवन वर्तमान में जर्जर स्थिति में है। अतः सर्वसम्मति से इसके जीर्णोद्धार के साथ-साथ उपलब्ध स्थल में अतिरिक्त भवन का निर्माण तथा इसके सुसज्जीकरण कराने का निर्णय लिया गया। इसके लिए कार्यपालक अभियंता, भवन प्रमण्डल, रामगढ़ को विद्यालय का निरीक्षण करके यथाशीघ्र DPR तैयार कर समर्पित करने का निदेश दिया गया, ताकि इसे विधिवत् ग्रामसभा से पारित कराकर DMFT के न्यास परिषद् में अनुमोदन हेतु प्रस्तुत किया जा सके। इनके द्वारा यह भी स्पष्ट किया गया कि विरहोर टोला में पेयजल सुविधा उपलब्ध कराने से संबंधित योजना ग्राम सभा से पारित हो गया है, लेकिन DMFT से अनुमोदन अपेक्षित है।

V. योजना की प्रशासनिक स्वीकृति

कार्यपालक अभियंता, पेयजल एवं स्वच्छता प्रमण्डल, रामगढ़ द्वारा बताया गया कि DMFT के तहत अनुमोदित नदी आधारित सात योजनाओं का DPR पूर्व में समर्पित किया गया है। इसके अतिरिक्त विरहोर टोला में पेयजल की सुविधा उपलब्ध कराने से संबंधित विभिन्न प्रखण्डों की 10 योजनाओं का DPR भी समर्पित किया गया है।

जिला योजना पदाधिकारी, रामगढ़ द्वारा बताया गया कि खान आयुक्त, उद्योग, खान एवं भूतत्व विभाग, राँची के ज्ञापांक 2882 दिनांक 22.11.2016 द्वारा मुख्य सचिव, झारखण्ड सरकार की अध्यक्षता में दिनांक 19.10.2016 को सम्पन्न जिला खजिन फाउण्डेशन ट्रस्ट(DMFT) कोष में संकलित राशि एवं कल्याणकारी योजनाओं से संबंधित बैठक की कार्यवाही प्रेषित की गयी है, जिसमें मुख्य सचिव द्वारा निदेश दिया गया है कि योजनाओं का चयन DMFT Rule एवं PMKKY के अनुरूप किया जाय। इसके लिए DPR संबंधित विभाग द्वारा तैयार कर तकनीकी स्वीकृति दी जाएगी। तकनीकी स्वीकृति प्राप्त होने के उपरांत DMFT Trust के प्रबंधकीय समिति के द्वारा प्रशासनिक स्वीकृति दी जाएगी।

A. मुख्य सचिव, झारखण्ड सरकार के उक्त निदेश के अनुसार कार्यपालक अभियंता, पेयजल एवं स्वच्छता प्रमण्डल, रामगढ़ द्वारा समर्पित तकनीकी स्वीकृति प्रदत्त प्राक्कलन तथा DMFT की बैठक प्राप्त अनुमोदन के अलोक नदी आधारित निम्न वर्णित सात योजनाओं की प्रशासनिक स्वीकृति प्रदान की गयी :-

- C. कार्यपालक अभियंता, पेयजल एवं स्वच्छता प्रमण्डल, रामगढ़ द्वारा बताया गया कि उनके द्वारा सौर्य ऊर्जा आधारित पेयजल की स्वीकृत योजनाओं में 175 योजनाओं की निविदा निकाली जा चुकी है और शेष योजनाओं की निविदा प्रकाशन प्रक्रिया में हैं। लगभग एक माह से अधिक समय व्यतीत हो जाने के बावजूद अभी तक निविदा प्रक्रिया के पूर्ण नहीं होने पर असंतोष व्यक्त किया गया तथा अविलम्ब सभी स्वीकृत योजनाओं का निविदा

निष्पादन करते हुए कार्य प्रारम्भ करने का निदेश दिया गया। साथ ही, DMFT के तहत स्वीकृत 46675 शौचालयों को गुणवत्ता पूर्वक निर्माण कराते हुए पूर्ण की गयी योजनाओं की सूची तथा फोटो समर्पित करने का निदेश दिया गया।

- D. DMFT के तहत कार्यान्वित योजनाओं के नियमित निरीक्षण, अनुश्रवण एवं गुणवत्ता की जाँच हेतु प्रखण्ड के लिए वरीय पदाधिकारियों की अध्यक्षता में कार्यपालक अभियंता तथा सहायक अभियंता की समिति गठित करने का निर्णय लिया गया।




